**Eastcote vs. Gerrards Cross**

**Sat. 19<sup>th</sup> April 2008**

**Eastcote 232-4 – Gerrards Cross 160-8  
Eastcote won by 72 runs**

With half of the team unavailable, Gerrards Cross made a losing start to the new cricket season going down by 72 runs to Eastcote.

In weather conditions that were more autumnal rather than spring like, Eastcote won the toss and opted to bat first. David Goodchild led the way with an unbeaten 102 off just 80 balls as Eastcote piled up a commanding 232-4 off their allotted 40 overs. The Cross bowlers held their own with Eastcote only taking control towards the end of the innings, hitting 102 off the last ten overs.

The Cross made a promising start to their reply with Malky Dhaliwal (31) and Sam Westaway (49) putting on 46 for the first wicket. Further contributions from Joe Keogh (18) and Steve Rimmer (26) kept the scoreboard moving. But the lack of first team players meant the required run rate was gradually increasing. A flurry of wickets ended the game as a contest and the Cross batted out their overs to finish on 160-8.
